Newsletter Mutanyana Weru Foundation June 2023

In our previous newsletters we reported about the death of Father André and the consequences for our Foundation. In the last few years before his death, we have often met with Father André exchanging ideas on how to proceed after his death.

His ideal was to empower his protégés so that they can be as independent as possible in the society after his passing. In recent years the severely disabled, housed in specially equipped accommodations. For the others, homes have been purchased or built so that all have found accommodation in family groups. Vegetable gardens were laid out at these shelters so that they could more or less provide for their own



needs. In addition, a piece of agricultural land has been made available where, through joint efforts, vegetables can be grown for own use and for the local market.

From the beginning of 2018, Father André has prepared his protégés that his help could end, given his age and therefore the support would also end.

Who could have imagined that December 2021 a Corona infection would be the end of life Father André would usher in.

Since the donations come almost entirely from relations, family and the congregation of Father André it becomes clear that this will come to an end in the near future.

In addition, the "Mutanyana Weru" foundation is statutorily linked to Father André, which means that the termination of the foundation must also be expected.

We as the foundation board decided in a meeting last May 2023 to stop the support at the end of 2024.

Of course we will also inform the protégés in Maputo, Mozambique of this decision so that they are prepared for this.

We will share the final termination of the "Mutanyana Weru" Foundation with the donors and other stakeholders.

As a board, we believe that we should inform you, as a donor in good time, about this proposed decisions and also thank you very much for the many years of support.

At the bottom of this newsletter you will find our Foundation's financial report for the 2022 financial year.

You can see here that on Dec. 2022 we had the amount of € 41 915.62 in cash. A simple calculation then shows that, if we spend € 2,000.00/month. transfer to our people in Maputo, we will run out of assets sometime at the end of 2024 and we will close then our Foundation.

A sad state of affairs but it is no different.
